## MB102 Tokens, Tickets and Passes, with Coin Weights, Scales & Balances

As many of you know, we're taking things slowly these days for health reasons so this sale is rather later than scheduled.

We begin with a collection of unofficial fobbers for which we have used Withers Token Book 2 as a reference which follows Bell and Whitmore. The Welsh pub checks follow the Cox brothers work: *Pub Checks of Wales 2005*. Other Welsh tokens can be found in *Cox Tokens, Checks, Metallic tickets, passes and tallies of Wales 1800-1993*. Two collections of tennis court fobs and barber check, are both interesting with a few rarities. They're in lots as they're inexpensive on a piece by piece basis - well worth looking at!

For the first time in ages we have a substantial consignment of coin weights, scales and balances. The coins are listed with reference to the Withers *British Coin Weights*. The scales and balances are interesting from a social history point of view with a great need to test gold coins in the 18th century and early 19th century. They were in common use from 1780's onwards by merchants or anybody using gold coinage. In Britain a lot of the early scales were made by the clockmakers in Merseyside around Prescot Ormskirk and Liverpool. These were precision instruments; the rocker balances that tested sovereigns rather than guineas (post 1825) were made mostly around Birmingham.

Do use the key word and category search facility on the internet and read right through the catalogue. There are crossovers between the categories especially on place names and themes; you may miss things otherwise.

All bidding will be done online with the usual closing time from 12 noon. You will need to register to bid and give yourself a user name. While you need to provide a debit or credit card to register, when you purchase from us you will have other options for payment. From the 'My Account' section you will be able to see what bids you're winning or losing, and can view your 'watch' list too. Please be sure to add our email address to your contacts (otherwise alerts from us may not reach you or end up in your junk folder).

**If you do not have access to the internet, we can bid on your behalf** as long as we receive instructions by **Monday 4 April, in the post or by email**, so you won't lose out with the new system. However, it is much, much better all round if you bid online.

Increments: Bids will increase in the following way:

£1-£20 £1 increments

£20-£40 £2 increments

£40-£100 £5 increments

£100 onwards £10 increments.

The auction uses proxy bidding so that you only see the current winning bid, not someone's maximum bid (think eBay). There won't be tied bids in the future - if someone else has bid your maximum before you, they win unless, offline bidders, we have your instruction to increase your bid by a set number of increments e.g. 1 or 2 bids. There's no third party sniping facility but of course you can bid up to (almost) the closing time online. Be aware though that once the auction is calculating winning bids at the end you may not be able to place last minute bids. You will get an alert by email for lots won; at that point go to My Account and checkout 'bids won'. That then creates an order and gives you options to pay. For our sanity we're **not charging a buyer's premium**. Also it may help our overseas buyers if faced with import charges.

The price online is the reserve if no bids registered. We reckon this is roughly half estimated price but loads of these tokens are seriously rare and known from only 1 or 2 examples. We're grateful for the assistance of certain collectors for their expertise. As ever with us, the majority of tokens in this listing are very modestly priced from the start and you may need to be brave if you really want a certain token. So bid high, and bid early please!
