




E03	A group of 5 Prize medals from Agricultural shows in Rochdale, Halifax and Accrington. Dates 1868-1973 won by a buck rabbit "Merrylegs" together with a photo of the owner, Oswald Wheeler and a clay pipe in the form of a hen's leg. Cu-Ni or white brass 65mm. all with two holes, probably to affix to rabbit hutch. See attached notes regarding the successes and tragic end of this buck rabbit. Note these look as though they were made by the same hand and not awarded by the various shows. We think these were attached to the hutches of the winning rabbit and possibly made by Mr Wheeler/	100
