




See Wikipedia: <i>He participated in <u>Fencing at the 1900 Summer Olympics in Paris</u> and won the <u>silver medal</u> in the master's foil. ¹ He was defeated by <u>Lucien Mérignac</u> in the final.</i></p> <p>copper electroformed plaque 75x45mm</p>	200
